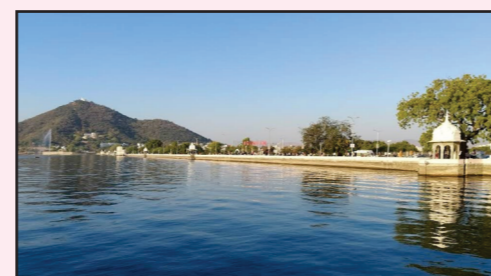

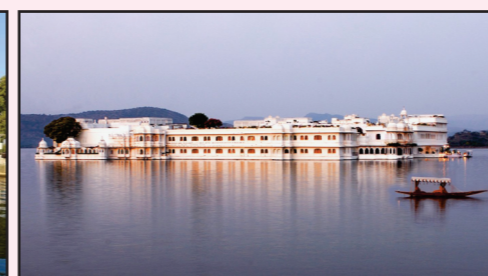

The University came into existence on 13 May, 2010. The headquarters of the university is located at Bikaner. At present, the University has three constituent colleges located at Bikaner, Udaipur and Jodhpur, contributing to veterinary education, research and extension services across the state.

ABOUT HOST INSTITUTE AND DEPARTMENT

The College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Navania, Vallabh Nagar, Udaipur is a constituent veterinary college of RAJUVAS, Bikaner. It is situated in the southern part of the Mewar region in Udaipur district, Rajasthan and was established in 2007. The premises of the college are spread over an area of 892 bighas (224 hectares) of land. The location of the college is about 40 km from the city of Udaipur, about 7 km interior from the Bhatwar bypass on the Udaipur-Chittorgarh National Highway. The college offers undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral programs, including B.V.Sc. & A.H., M.V.Sc. and Ph.D. degrees in most disciplines, along with diploma programmes in Animal Husbandry. The Department of Veterinary and Animal Husbandry Extension Education offers U.G, P.G and AHD programmes, supported by well-equipped laboratories, modern infrastructural facilities as well as a departmental museum and library.

ABOUT SOCIETY FOR VETERINARY EXTENSION (FORMERLY IVEF)

The Society for Veterinary Extension (SVE), formerly known as the Indian Veterinary Extension Forum (IVEF), is a professional organization dedicated to advancing the field of veterinary and animal husbandry extension in India. It serves as a dynamic platform for academicians, researchers and extension professionals to share knowledge, exchange ideas and enhance professional competence. The origin of the society dates back to February 2006, when the Indian Veterinary Extension Forum (IVEF) was registered (Reg. No. 241 of 2006) under the Societies Registration Act at Puducherry. Since its inception, IVEF has played a significant role in promoting knowledge dissemination through international & national conferences, workshops/seminars and other academic activities, marking significant milestones in its continued efforts. In order to further strengthen and expand its vision and objectives and to rule out certain official obligations, it was unanimously resolved to reconstitute the organization under a new identity. Consequently, IVEF was re-registered as the Society for Veterinary Extension (SVE) (Reg. No. 65 of 2026) at Puducherry on 26 March 2026 under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and SVE came into existence. This conference is going to mark a breakthrough in history of reconstitution of the new society for veterinary extension profession.

VENUE - UDAIPUR

Udaipur, one of the most beautiful cities of Rajasthan and India, holds a prominent place on the international tourist map. Popularly known as the "City of Lakes" and the "Venice of the East," it is renowned for its enchanting scenic beauty, rich cultural heritage and majestic architecture. The city is home to several iconic attractions such as the City Palace, Jag Mandir, Lake Palace, Saheliyon Ki Bari, Monsoon Palace, Ahar Museum, Sajjangarh Biological Park, Gagdish Temple, Sahastra Bahu Temple, Pratap Gaurav Kendra and numerous picturesque lakes including Fateh Sagar, Pichola, Udai Sagar, Doodh Talai, Jaisamand and Badi Lake, all contributing to its breathtaking landscape.

The famous Shrinathji Temple at Nathdwara (about 45 km), the historic Haldighati Battlefield (about 45 km), the magnificent Kumbhalgarh Fort (about 85 km) and the historic Chittorgarh Fort (about 110 km), are popular nearby destinations. Religious sites such as the Eklingji Temple (around 21 km), the Ranakpur Jain Temple (around 90 km) and Mount Abu (around 165 km) further enhance the spiritual and cultural significance of the region. Rich in history and culture, Udaipur is closely associated with the legacy of Maharana Pratap, making it not only a tourist destination but also a symbol of valor and heritage.

TRANSPORT

Udaipur is well connected by road, rail and air. It is linked by regular flights from Maharana Pratap Airport, located about 20 km from the city, with connections to Delhi, Mumbai, Jaipur, Kolkata and Ahmedabad. It has excellent rail connectivity to Jaipur, Delhi, Mumbai, Mathura, Indore, Agra, Ahmedabad, Patna, Bengaluru and Kolkata through Udaipur City Railway

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Research abstracts (maximum of 300 words) are invited on the listed themes of the conference. Papers should be based on the original research and field experiences focusing on any of the themes. The abstract must be submitted as a soft copy in MS Word format, typed in Times New Roman font, size 12, with single line spacing. The presenting author's name should be clearly highlighted along with their email address and mobile number. Each abstract must include the title of the paper, name(s) of the author(s), institutional address, objectives of the study, a brief description of the methodology, summary of the results and the conclusions.

The soft copy of the abstract must reach the Organizing Secretary on or before 31st July 2026 via email at ncsveudaipur2026@gmail.com or website: ncsveudaipur.in. Only papers submitted by registered candidates will be accepted. Accepted papers for oral presentation will be allotted a maximum of 5 minutes for PowerPoint presentation followed by 2 minutes for discussion. Abstracts selected for poster presentation must be prepared in the size of 3 feet by 4 feet in portrait orientation using biodegradable material and displayed in the space allotted.

AWARDS

- Best Oral and Poster Presentation Awards:** Best presentation awards will be given for Oral and Poster categories, separately for students (UG, PG/PhD) and faculty, in each session.
- SVE Young Scientist Award:** Applicants who are life members of SVE (formerly IVEF), up to 40 years of age and working in academic or research institutions should submit their academic and professional details along with a full paper not exceeding 5000 words by 31 July 2026 via email.
- SVE Women Extension Scientist Award:** Same as SVE Young Scientist Award (Only women applicants who are life members for at least five years and above 40 years of age)
- SVE Best Extension Scientist Award:** Same as SVE Young Scientist Award (Applicants who are life members for at least five years and aged 41-55 years)
- Best M.V.Sc. & Ph.D. Thesis (Veterinary Extension) Award:** Open to life member M.V.Sc. and Ph.D. students (separately) with theses submitted during 2024-2026; submit application by 31 July 2026 via email.
- National Extension Quiz Competition Awards (UG Students)**
- National Fellow Award:** Senior faculty members (aged 50 and above), active life members with significant contributions to the society & discipline. Eligible candidates may be nominated by members of the Executive Committee (EC) or apply directly.
